Clearly there will be international trade exchange in nuclear technology, including construction, fabrication of a, fuel fabrication, maintenance system development, and considerably more.

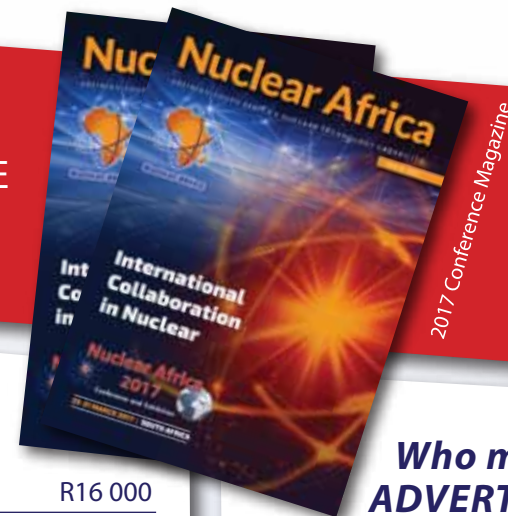
